



## Spokane Girls Fastpitch Invitational

### Tournament Rules

(Revised 06-13-2008)

1. Tournament play will be as per ASA code except for the following:
  - a. 15 run rule after 3 and 10 run rule after 5 innings will be in effect for all games, Championship game optional.
  - b. The ASA tiebreaker will be used after 7 innings or 1-1/2 hours of play.
  - c. There will be a 1-1/2 hour time limit for all games except: optional on Championship game.
  - d. A flip of the coin by umpire will determine the home team.
  - e. The home team will be responsible for the official scorebook.
  - f. The Tournament Director and the UIC will settle all protest on the field.
  - g. No infield practice will be allowed prior to the start of the game.
  - h. Re-entry for an injured player will be allowed.
  - i. **10u & 12u only: A team's turn at bat shall end immediately when they score their fifth run in any inning, except the seventh inning (or any inning declared by the umpire, before play has begun in the top of that inning, to be the last inning)**
  - j. **10u ONLY:**
    1. Teams will have the option of batting their entire lineup.
    2. No new inning, other than a tie-breaker inning, will start more than one hour and thirty minutes after the actual game starting time.
    3. CAN steal more than one base at a time
    4. CAN steal home
    5. CAN run on a dropped third strike
  - k. **12u ONLY: Pool Play & Round Robin play ONLY – CAN bat their entire lineup**
2. Two pick-up players will be allowed as per ASA
3. Head Coaches are to check in 30 minutes before game time. **Head Coaches will provide umpire and other team with a copy of their line-up, listing players by first and last name and uniform number.**
4. Tournament play will start no later than 10:00 am Saturday.
5. Head Coaches, players and fans are expected to display sportsmanlike conduct on and off the playing field. Un-sportsmanlike conduct may be grounds for removal from the tournament.
6. Placement in the Sunday rounds will be based on:
  - a. overall record in pool play
  - b. head to head play
  - c. number of runs scored against a team
  - d. coin toss
